

# A HOME ACCESSIBILITY DECISION CHECKLIST

Use this guide to evaluate your options before deciding whether to move or adapt your current home for accessibility.

## EMOTIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

- ☐ Do you feel a strong emotional attachment to your current home and neighborhood?
- ☐ Are your family, friends, and community close by?
- ☐ Would leaving your home cause significant stress or anxiety?

## SAFETY AND CONVENIENCE

- ☐ Would having a lift or elevator improve your independence and reduce fall risk?
- ☐ Are there family members (spouse, children, grandchildren) who would benefit from improved accessibility?
- ☐ Are daily tasks like carrying groceries, laundry, or moving between floors becoming difficult?

## FINANCIAL FACTORS

- ☐ Have you calculated the full cost of moving (sale, purchase, renovations, moving fees)?
- ☐ Have you compared that to the estimated cost of installing a home elevator or lift?
- ☐ Are you aware that home elevators can increase your property value?

## FUTURE PLANNING

- ☐ Are you planning for potential future mobility changes (injury, illness, aging)?
- ☐ Would you prefer to age in place rather than move multiple times?
- ☐ Have you explored all available home modification options, including lifts and elevators?

## HOME LAYOUT AND FUNCTIONALITY


- ☐ Does your home have multiple levels or stairs that are becoming challenging?
- ☐ Are there rooms you've already converted or plan to convert for accessibility (e.g., basement kitchen)?
- ☐ Could a compact, modern elevator or lift be added to your home with little to no renovation—or just a few simple adjustments?
